



Consortium for Scenario Planning 2019 Conference Early Draft Conference Program May 28, 2019

Wednesday, November 6

- The conference will begin with afternoon sessions around 1 pm.
- The host, Capitol Region Council of Governments, will determine the content of afternoon sessions.
- A walking tour of downtown Hartford will take place between the afternoon sessions and a networking reception in the evening.
- The networking reception will end around 7 pm.

Thursday, November 7

- Sessions selected through the call for session proposals will take place in the morning, beginning around 9 am.
- Lunch will be provided with conference registration. "Lightning talks," a 2-minute opportunity to share recent updates, ideas, or questions with attendees will take place during lunch.
- In the afternoon, a number of sessions will be provided with potential topics such as:
 - An overview of the progress made on working group and Request for Proposal (RFP) projects during 2019
 - Peer exchange "speed dating" to match more experienced scenario planners with less experienced scenario planners getting ready to embark on new scenario planning efforts
 - Working group session to identify new efforts and projects for 2020

Friday, November 8

- Friday morning will open with an "unconference." An unconference is an
 interactive event, in this case a component of a conference, which allows ideas
 to come from anyone and with short notice. This enables the latest ideas to
 emerge and be proposed democratically, with attendees "voting with their feet."
- After the unconference, voting will take place for 2020 Consortium board positions.
- A networking lunch will be provided with conference registration. Over lunch, attendees who are also board members will take part in a board meeting in a separate room from the networking lunch.
- The conference will adjourn around 1 pm.
