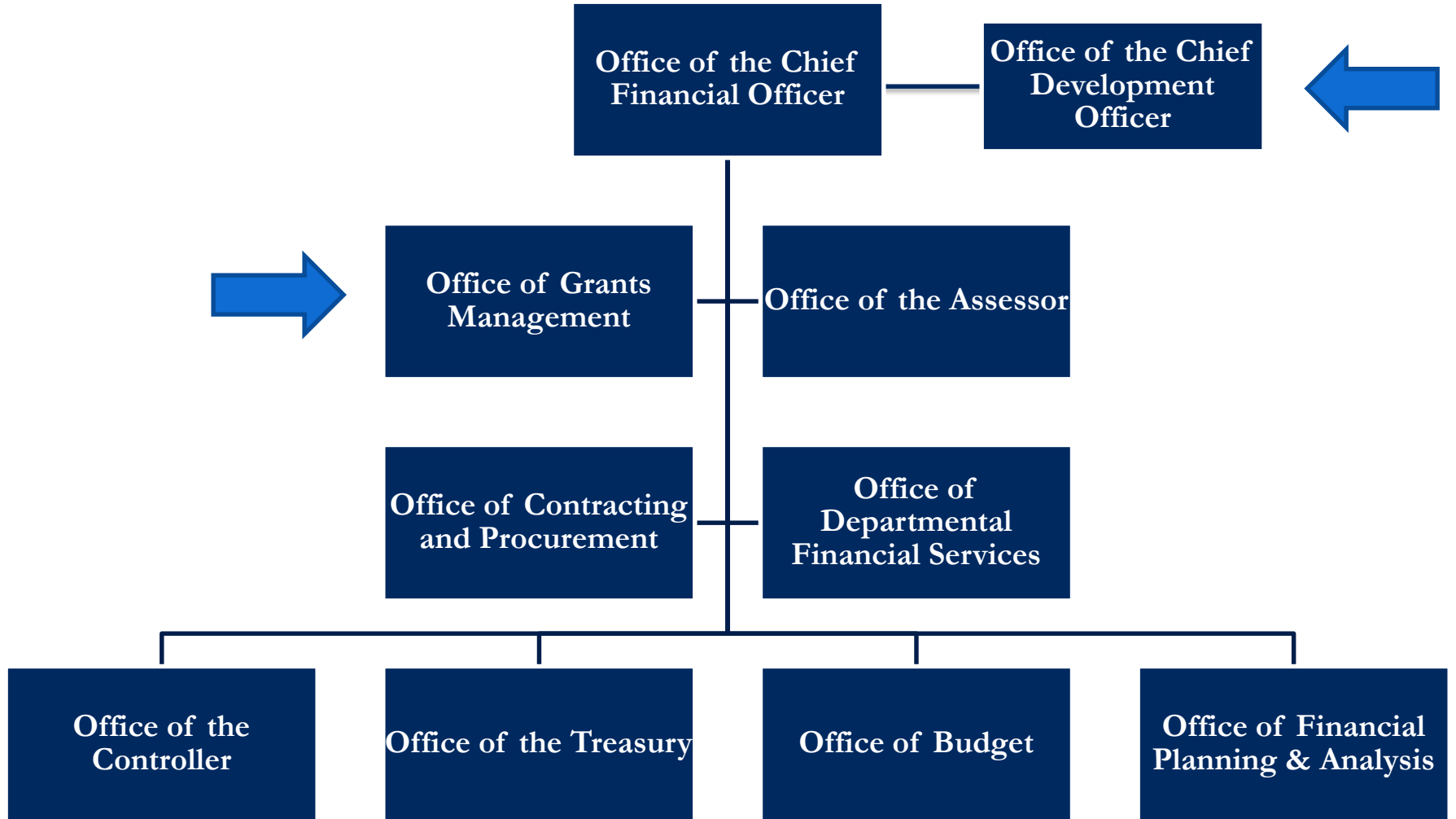

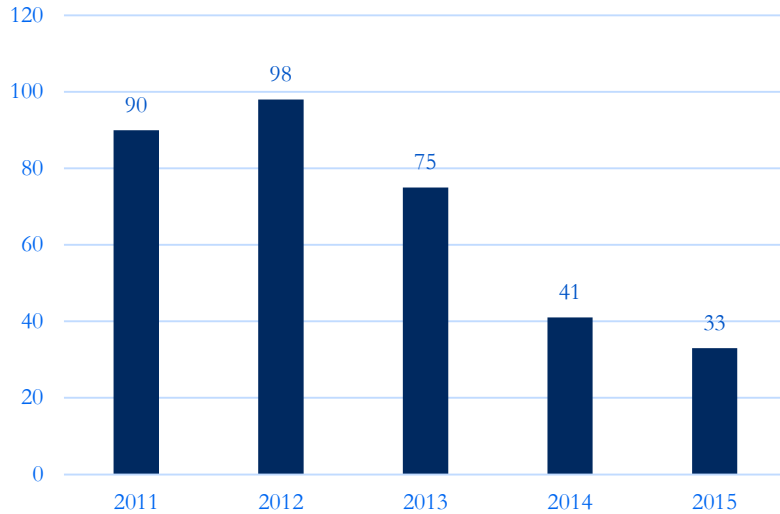

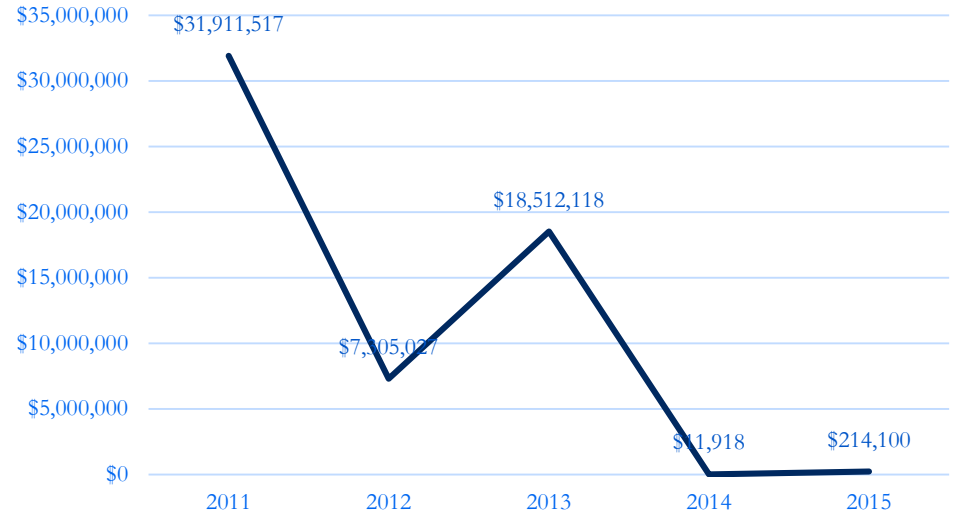

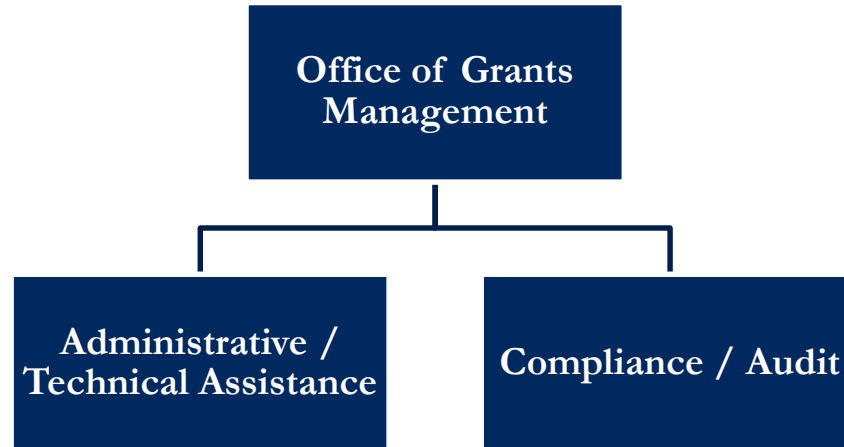
Amount of Questioned Costs

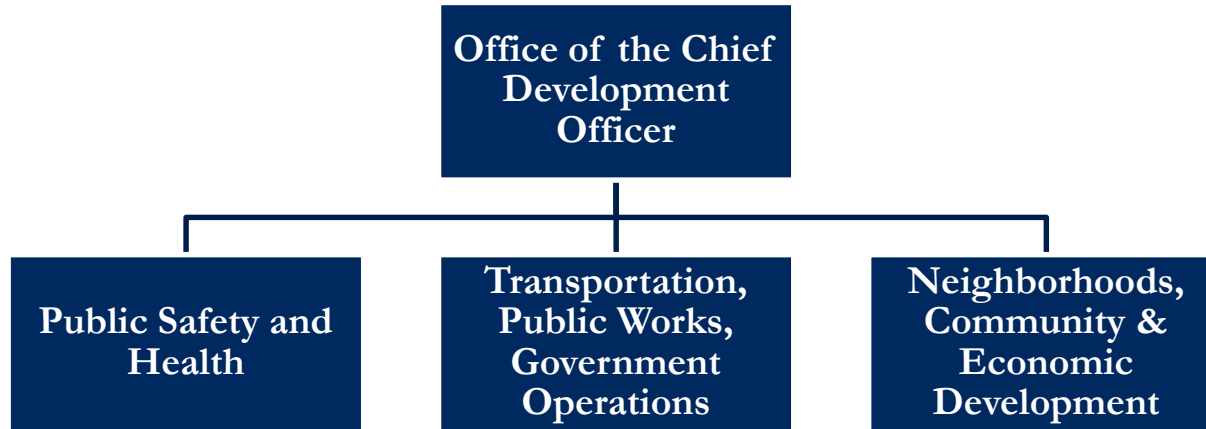
OGM Organizational Chart and Mission
